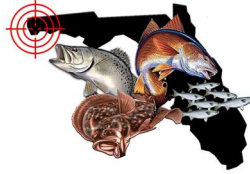


Northwest Florida Inshore Shootout

NORTHWEST FLORIDA INSHORE SHOOTOUT



Tournament Location: Archie Glover Boat Launch

Dates: September 26th 12:01 AM – 27th 5:00 PM

Entry Fee: \$300 entry fee per boat to be eligible for the Inshore Slam and the Redfish Aggregate. 100% payout.

Payout Structure for the Inshore Slam

- If less than 20 boats, 1st thru 3rd in the following structure:
 - 1st place – 50%, 2nd place – 30%, 3rd place – 20%
- If 20+ boats 1st thru 4th in the following structure:
 - 1st place – 50%, 2nd place 25%, 3rd place 15%, 4th place 10%

Payout Structure for the Redfish Aggregate (2 fish aggregate, heaviest total weight wins)

- \$5,000 total payout
 - 1st place – \$3,000, 2nd place – \$2,000

Calcuttas: \$100 Flounder, \$100 Redfish, \$100 Speckled Trout, \$100 Final Day Slam, \$100 Redfish Aggregate

- If 1-4 entries, only pays out 1st
- If 5-9 entries, only pays out 1st and 2nd
- If 10+ entries, pays out 1st thru 3rd

Money Prizes: \$1,000 for heaviest Flounder weighed, \$1,000 for heaviest Speckled Trout weighed, \$1,000 for heaviest Redfish weighed (limited to one prize per boat, if applicable will be decided by weigh-in time).

TOURNAMENT RULES

REGISTRATION: Registration for the Northwest Florida Inshore Shootout can be completed remotely or via cash delivery anytime between August 11th and September 25th at 7pm. Registration for the 2nd Annual Northwest Florida Shootout can be completed in the following ways: (1) Cash to Griffin Wilson or Alex Johnson, (2) CashApp - \$fsuale2022, (3) PayPal - @Johnson82810, or (4) Venmo - @Alex-Johnson-1125. Following registration teams must text either Alex (850-548-5616) or Griffin (850-776-2184) their four participating anglers along with their team name.

FISHING TIME: Fishing will begin at 12:01AM on Saturday September 26th, no fishing before this time is permitted. All team anglers must be on the same vessel at all times during fishing time. All anglers must be in line to weigh in at Archie Glover Boat Launch no later than 5:00pm on Sunday September 27st.

SCALES/WEIGH-IN LOCATION: The scales will be located at Archie Glover Boat Launch; this will be a one-day weigh in taking place on Sunday September 27st. The scales open at 3pm and all anglers must be at the scales no later than 5pm. Late arrival to the scales will result in an immediate disqualification.

VESSEL REQUIREMENT: All fishing must be completed from a boat, no fishing from kayaks, canoes, or paddle boards will be permitted. No wade fishing or fishing from land will be permitted. No boat can have more than four anglers. Anglers are strictly prohibited from splitting up and fishing on different vessels from one another during fishing hours.

BOUNDARIES: The boundaries will only permit fishing between the west boundary, Highway 59 bridge in Gulf Shores, Alabama, to the east boundary, the Hwy 331 bridge in Destin, Florida.

PRIZES: The Inshore Slam prizes will be awarded to the boats weighing in the heaviest three fish total (one from each eligible species) over the tournament. If there are no fish entered in all three categories by one boat, then the heaviest total from the two categories will be used. The Redfish Aggregate cash prizes will be awarded according to the rules amongst the top three boats weighing the heaviest weights on their respective two slot redfish combined. Bonus prizes and cash awards are supplemental prizes. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by the earliest official weigh-in time.

MEASUREMENT: Fish will be measured using the Check-It Stik brand redfish series board seen below. All redfish will be measured with the tail pincher running to the 26" line per tournament standard



RIGHT OF WEIGHMASTER: The Weighmaster maintains the right on any fish deemed suspicious to cut open the fish for inspection.

RULE ENFORCEMENT: All winners are subject to a polygraph and the Rules Committee maintains the right to disqualify a team if a determination is made that the fish was captured against tournament rules, mutilated, or tampered with for any reason.

RULES COMMITTEE: The rules committee includes the Tournament Directors and the Weighmaster.

PROTEST: All formal protests must be written and submitted to the rules committee with a \$200.00 cash fee by 8pm on Sunday September 27th. All protests will be reviewed by the rules committee and all protesters are subject to a polygraph exam. Participants under 18 years of age are not subject to a polygraph exam, but a parent/guardian can be. If a protest is upheld the challenger will receive all or a partial refund of the protest fee minus the polygraph charge. If a protest is NOT upheld, the protest fee is forfeited to the event.

ELIGIBLE SPECIES: Redfish, Speckled Trout, and Flounder are the only eligible species.

COMPLIANCE: All fish must be legal to keep and comply with FWC rules and regulations. Length Requirements: Redfish – measured with the pinched tail not less than 18" or more than 27"; Speckled Trout – Not less than 15" or more than 19" may not possess more than one over 19" per vessel; and Flounder – minimum length of 14".

METHOD OF CAPTURE: All fish must be caught by rod and reel using either live bait, dead bait, or artificial lure. No fish caught via gig, net, spear, or snagging method will be permitted.

WEATHER: This is a Captain's choice tournament, however, in the event of severe inclement weather conditions, the tournament may be rescheduled for another weekend. Five hours of fishing constitutes a day of fishing and one day of fishing constitutes a tournament.

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
