



ROBERTSON ISLAND REDFISH CUP

When: Saturday, March 14th, 2026

Entry Fee: \$300.00 per boat (teams of 2 Anglers) 100% of entry fees will be paid out in cash.

Optional Cash Calcutta: \$100.00 big fish Calcutta. 100% of Calcutta entries will be paid out in cash.

Details: Teams will compete for the heaviest bag of 2 live Redfish within the FWCC slot range (18"-27").

Registration: Registration will be held at Outcast Tackle & Marine in Pensacola, FL on Wednesday, March 11th, 2026 from 4pm - 8pm CST. Registration is CASH only. Any questions regarding registration, please reach us at (850) 485 - 0680.

Tournament bags & shirts will be available for pickup at the Island during weigh-in & awards presentation.

Check Out & Shotgun Start: Check out will be at Shoreline Park in Gulf Breeze, FL on March 14th, 2026. Your team must check out anytime between 5am - 6:15am CST with an RIRC representative at the Shoreline Park boat launch. All boats must remain within clear

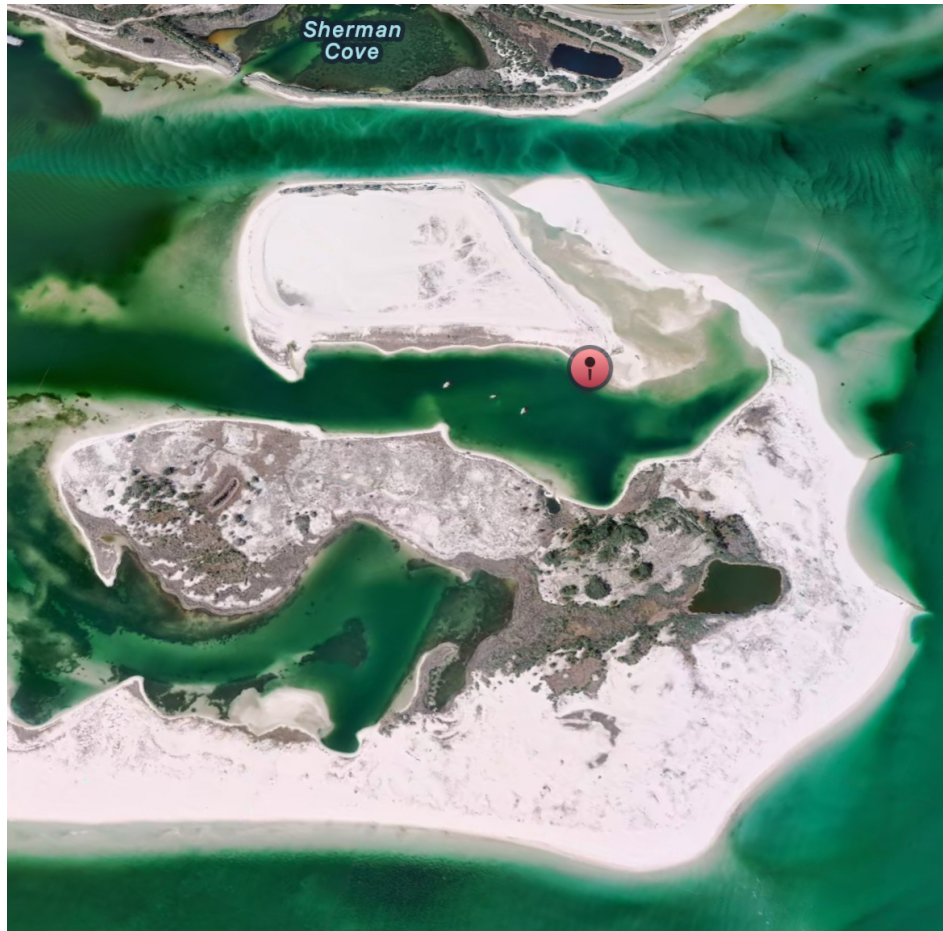
sight of Shoreline Park until the shotgun start at approximately 6:30am CST.



Fishing Boundaries: No boundaries. You may travel anywhere **by boat** to fish following the shotgun start. Removing your boat from the water after the shotgun start (prior to weighing fish) is prohibited.

Weigh-in: The weigh-in will be held at Robertson Island in Pensacola, FL at 4pm CST on Saturday March 14th, 2026. Robertson Island is only accessible by boat. All anglers must be at the island to weigh fish NLT 4pm CST. This means your boat must be within clear sight of the weigh-in location NLT 4pm CST. Awards

presentation following completion of the weigh-in. Exact location of the weigh-in is marked below:



Rules: All Redfish must be caught on rod & reel between the hours of 6:30am & 4pm CST on Saturday March 14th, 2026 by a registered team member from their registered boat. Live bait, dead bait, and artificial baits are all allowed.

Each team is allowed to weigh a two person's legal bag limit of Redfish. All Redfish must be alive when brought to the scales. Any dead fish rendered for weight will be assessed a half pound penalty per dead fish.

All fish must comply with FWCC regulations: Redfish – measured with the pinched tail not less than 18” or more than 27”.

All measurements will be done using an RIRC provided Check-it Stick (slant board) utilizing the perfect pinch. All measurements will be done by sliding the perfect pinch to the 26” mark and taking the length at the longest point of the tail. Redfish will be measured using a “hands off” approach.

Redfish will be measured belly side down on the slant board. Redfish that are touching the 27” mark will be considered legal.

Participants may not attempt to intentionally manipulate the weight or length of any fish. All fish will be measured on the same measuring device and weighed on the same tournament scale. Redfish will only be weighed one time. All weights are final.

Payouts & Prizes: Payouts will be to the top 3 teams (50% 30%, 20% split) weighing in the 2 heaviest Redfish. Optional cash Calcutta's will be paid out to the top 3 teams (50%, 30%, 20% split). The top 3 teams (heaviest bag weights) will receive big checks and custom RIRC artwork/trophies.

Tie Results: In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by the weight of the teams largest fish. If still tied, the team who weighed in first will be declared the winner. A tie in big fish Calcutta will go to the team who weighed the fish in first.

Weather: RIRC understands that a lot goes into fishing a competitive inshore tournament, and most Anglers don't prefer to fish in excessive wind & rain (particularly for a shotgun start style tournament). If the forecast is looking excessively windy or rainy, a

call will be made by 4pm CST on Wednesday March 11th, 2026 whether to postpone to a later date/time.

Final Decisions/Disclaimer: The Tournament Director may implement additional rules and restrictions if deemed necessary. Entrants are responsible for understanding all RIRC rules. The Tournament Director will have the final say in all Sportsmanship and Conduct matters. All decisions of the Tournament Director, judges, and weighmaster are final.

All registered anglers understand that they are fishing by their own will and will hold harmless any affiliate of RIRC. All Anglers are expected to use safe fishing and boating practices.
